Day 1: Saturday 17 July **Arrival in Louisville, KY**

Depart your 'HOME' city and transfer to **Louisville International Airport (SDF)**. Upon arrival, transfer to our centrally located hotel for check-in. This afternoon meet your Tour Manager in the lobby and board your coach and transfer to **Frazier History Museum** and **Kentucky Bourbon Trail Welcome Center**, the Official Starting Point of The Kentucky Bourbon Trail. *The Spirit of Kentucky* Bourbon exhibition provides a fantastic overview of the history of Bourbon and why Bourbon is so vital to Kentucky. Enjoy your first Multi-brand Bourbon tasting!

Day 2: Sunday 18 July **Louisville, KY**

Begin the day at two of the most iconic and beloved Kentucky institutions! Enjoy a traditional Southern breakfast as you watch the morning workouts of some of the finest thoroughbreds in the world at **Churchill Downs**. Then, tour the museum that is dedicated to the 'most exciting two minutes in sports,' the Kentucky Derby. Then we will visit the **Louisville Slugger Museum and Factory**. This afternoon, enjoy a tour of the **Brown-Forman Cooperage**! See how coopers make the barrels for world-famous bourbon brands including **Old Forester**, **Woodford Reserve**, and **Coopers' Craft**. Later, we learn about the past, present and future of bourbon at the historic **Stitzel- Weller Distillery**, ending with a tasting.

Dinner On Your Own

Day 3: Monday 19 July **Owensboro, KY**

After breakfast, board your coach and depart for Owensboro. Upon arrival, visit the **Bluegrass Music Hall of Fame and Museum** to catch a show and tour the museum. This afternoon we visit the **Green River Distilling Co.**, occupying the revived Charles Medley Distillery site, they have been distilling the best Kentucky Bourbon and Rye since resurrecting and reopening this historic distillery in 2016. Following Dinner, enjoy a nightcap at Spirits, one of the largest bourbon bars in America. It's located in the basement of **The Miller House**. This historic Sears-Roebuck house was brought back to life.

Day 4: Tuesday 20 July **Clarksville, TN**

After breakfast, board your coach and depart for Clarksville, TN. On our way, our first stop will be to tour the **Fort Campbell Military Post**, home to the famed **101st Airborne Division's Screaming Eagles** (Air Assault). Then we visit the **Beachaven Vineyards & Winery**, one of the largest wineries in the state and the only one in Tennessee that produces French Method Champagne. Take a tour and have a tasting. Today we end with a dinner event at **Old Glory Distillery** with a cocktail making contest!

Day 5: Wednesday 21 July Clarksville, TN

After breakfast, we visit the **Historic Collinsville** pioneer settlement shows the story of life in rural Tennessee from 1830-1900. The authentic period furnishings and artifacts in 16 restored log homes and outbuildings chronicle life before and after the Civil War. Scattered throughout the 40-acre grounds are picnic areas and walking trails. This afternoon, enjoy a demonstration of biscuit making and preparing for the “Great Biscuit Backoff”. Tonight with will enjoy a Civil War era Cotillion!

Day 6: Thursday 22 July Nashville, TN

After breakfast, we depart for **Nashville, TN**. On our way to Nashville, we will visit **Prichard’s Distillery** for tour and tasting. Prichard’s Distillery hand crafts our American distilled spirits in small batches. Their quality rums and whiskeys are distilled in copper pots and stored in 15-gallon to 53-gallon charred white oak barrels to allow for the best possible flavor. Upon arrival into Nashville, enjoy a visit to the **Country Music Hall of Fame**, where you can hear rare recordings of country’s legendary performers, see behind-the-scenes films by today’s stars, along with costumes, instruments and personal treasures from country music’s past and present. Enjoy **Nashville Hot Chicken** and killer cocktails at **Party Fowl**, followed by some leisure time to enjoy the famous **Honky-Tonks** along Broadway.

Day 7: Friday, 23 July Nashville, TN

This morning, enjoy a tour of the historic **Ryman Auditorium** and **RCA’s Studio B**, followed by a visit to the **Nashville Farmers Market**, **Tennessee State Museum** and **Bicentennial State Park**. For lunch, enjoy some more BBQ at **Peg Leg Porker** in the trendy neighborhood **The Gulch**. This afternoon, visit **Nelson's Green Brier Distillery** where you will be guided through the past and present history of this storied distillery. The interactive and guided demonstration will begin with a cocktail made from one of their most popular spirits and will be accompanied by four other seasonal offerings. Tonight, attend a performance at the **Grand Ole Opry**.

I. Payment Schedule

- A. Reservations for participation in the **BBQ, Bluegrass, & Booze** are accepted on a first-come basis
 - 1. reservations can be secured by submitting a \$400 per person deposit
 - 2. early deposits are encouraged, with the first payment due no later than **January 22, 2021**
- B. The 2nd payment is \$400 per person due **March 19, 2021**
- C. The 3rd payment is \$400 per person due **May 3, 2021**
- D. **The final balance, estimated at \$299 per person, is due June 1, 2021**
- E. Billing Statements will be mailed out 30 days prior to next installment after the initial deposit is received.
- F. Billing Statements will be based upon your number of participants, and will indicate payment due dates, reflect your hotel occupancy choices, include airfare (if applicable), include the airport/hotel transportation fees (if applicable), include costs for extra nights in hotel if elected and available, costs for optional provisions (if applicable), and include your payment summary.
- G. Billing Statements will be adjusted to reflect your housing choices; any additional charges based upon hotel upgrade costs or other services purchased are due 30 days prior to arrival. Adjustments and payment due dates are indicated on your monthly statements.

 - 3. 100% of deposits become non-refundable on **June 17, 2021** (*30 days prior to departure*)
 - a) All fees are non-refundable for participants that cancel after **June 17, 2021** (*30 days prior to departure*)
 - 4. Name substitutions/replacements, without penalty, are permissible
 - 5. Qualified refunds will not be returned until the final adjusted invoice has been paid
 - 6. If your tour becomes canceled by Sechrist Travel, all monies are completely and immediately refunded to you
