- Enjoy the exceptional wine regions of La Rioja and El Bierzo



<u>Day 1: Sunday 25 September Departure</u> Overnight flight to Madrid-Barajas Airport (MAD)

Day 2: Monday 26 September Arrival in Madrid, SPAIN

Morning arrival into Madrid–Barajas Airport (MAD). After customs formalities the group will be welcomed by your tour manager and board our waiting motor-coach. You will head north of Madrid and across the mountains before continuing through the plains of Castile with its main river, the Duero. We will visit Peñafiel and one of the wineries of Ribera del Duero before lunch. You will enjoy the local asados and lamb with the Ribera del Duero wines. After a short drive, you will arrive to the Cemetery of Sad Hill and Canyon. Sad Hill cemetery is the setting for the climax of The Good, the Bad and the Ugly. Later we will visit the Monastery of Silos and attend the Vespers service where the Benedictine monks will sing Gregorian chant. You will continue to our accommodation in an ancient monastery in Lerma or in Silos

Group Welcome Dinner Provided

Day 3: Tuesday 27 September Burgos - Camino de Santiago - La Rioja

After breakfast, we will visit the ancient city of **Burgos** and it's cathedral where you will meet your first pilgrims on the way to Santiago. The **Monastery of Las Huelgas** and the gothic Cathedral, celebrating its 800th year before following the **Camino De Santiago** to the **La Rioja region**. Once in the area you will visit a centenary winery run by the fifth generation of winemakers. After the experience you will make it to the fantastic accommodation in the heart of La Rioja wine region. Dinner and overnight stay at the **Palacio Tondon**, by the banks of the river Ebro.

Day 4: Wednesday 28 September La Rioja

After breakfast, La Rioja obviously is more than wine and a superb gastronomy, it is also rich in art, history and nature. Today you will sample some of this other amazing features of this area. We will visit medieval villages, monasteries,... At the end of the day, we will be back to the hustle of the capital of La Rioja, Logroño. Tonight we will experience a traditional tapas dinner. Overnight stay at Palacio Tondon.

Day 5: Thursday 29 September Camino de Santiago - Leon

After breakfast, we depart La Rioja following the Camino de Santiago towards the ancient kingdom of Leon. We will visit the small villages of Castrojeriz and Fromista to visit some of the most unique 1000 year old churches and learn about the Romanesque Art and the legends of this millenary road. We will visit one of the D.O. (Denomination of Origin) Vinos de Leon wineries before arriving to the ancient city of Leon. Once in the heart of the city, you will the opportunity to stroll around one of the most outstanding cathedrals of Spain. We will enjoy a wine together in an amazing neighborhood known as the Barrio Humedo before checking at the hotel. We will spend the night at the Parador de San Marcos, one of the best examples of the Renaissance architecture in Spain, built at the time of the Catholic monarchs as a pilgrim's hospital and monastery. Dinner and overnight stay. (*) Alternative accommodation will be San Isidoro de Leon, that was also monastery and cloister located on top of the pantheon of the Kings of Leon that preserves the best Romanesque frescos.

Day 6: Friday 30 September Camino De Santiago - El Bierzo - Galicia - Santiago

After breakfast, we depart from **Leon** towards the **El Bierzo** wine region, where we will learn about the **Mencia grapes**, a very old and unique grape variety before crossing the boundaries with the most western most lands of Spain, **Galicia**. We will stop in some of the beautiful villages and, if weather permits, take the chance to walk a little stretch of the Camino; feel like a pilgrim for a while! We will arrive to **Santiago de Compostela** in the afternoon to enjoy a walk through its old town and enjoy some tasting experience of **D.O Albariño** and **Riberio** local wines. Santiago de Compostela will be the right place to get lost and enjoy dinner on your own. Overnight stay in Santiago de Compostela. **Dinner On Your Own**

Day 7: Saturday 1 October Santiago de Compostela

After breakfast, our local guide will take us around to visit the unique **Romanesque Cathedral** and you will understand why over a millennium millions of pilgrims struggled walking for months to arrive to this holy place. Its cobbled stone streets, its granite fortress-like palaces and humble churches irradiates spirituality. You will have the rest of the day at leisure to complete the discovery of the city on your own before we gather together for dinner. Your guides will give you some recommendations to try the local gastronomy based mainly on fish, seafood and fresh vegetables. Dinner and overnight stay in Santiago de Compostela

Day 8: Sunday 2 October Santiago de Compostela - Ribera Sacra - Salamanca

After breakfast, leaving behind Santiago and driving west towards the central plains of the peninsula but still in Galicia region, we will stop to visit the **D.O Ribera Sacra** and taste some of their best wines and visiting one of the family owned wineries perched on the mountains overlooking the river banks. We will arrive to **Salamanca** in the afternoon. After checking you will have time for a brief stroll around some of the most significant places of what it is consider the third oldest university city in Europe . Overnight stay in Salamanca.

Dinner On Your Own

Day 9: Monday 3 October Salamanca - Segovia - Madrid

After breakfast, leave this university city towards **Madrid**, with a last stop in **Segovia**, a fairy tale sight, where you will enjoy its old quarter, the Plaza Mayor, the Alcazar and the Roman Aqueduct. We will stop in **Jose Maria Restaurant**, that owns one of the best wineries of **Ribera del Duero**. We will continue to Madrid where you will arrive with some time to rest before enjoying your Farewell Dinner in the heart of the city. Overnight stay.

- A. Reservations for participation in the **Monasteries & Wine** are accepted on a first-come basis
 - 1. reservations can be secured by submitting a \$500 per person deposit
 - 2. early deposits are encouraged, with the first payment due no later than March 15, 2022
- B. The 2nd payment is \$1000 per person due April 30, 2022
- C. The 3rd payment is \$1000 per person due June 15, 2022
- D. The final balance, estimated at \$399 per person, is due August 15, 2022
- E. Billing Statements will be mailed out 30 days prior to next installment after the initial deposit is received.
- F. Billing Statements will be based upon your number of participants, and will indicate payment due dates, reflect your hotel occupancy choices, include airfare (if applicable), include the airport/hotel transportation fees (if applicable), include costs for extra nights in hotel if elected and available, costs for optional provisions (if applicable), and include your payment summary.
